Best Kept Front Garden Competition

Front gardens will be assessed on the following criteria:

- A pleasing first impression and overall impact
- Variety of plant range, with few or no weeds
- Good planning in layout and selection of plants
- Good floral colour combinations
- Paving and garden structures that complement, not dominate
- Evidence of recycling (e.g. use of grey water)
- A tidy appearance all round

Who can enter?

- Hailsham residents (front gardens only)

Best Kept Allotment Competition

Judges will be looking for:

- Variety and quality of the crop(s)
- Environmental sustainability
- Control of weeds and litter
- Effective use of compost
- Use of grey water and mulch (and other water conservation activities)
- General appearance of the plot

Who can enter?

- Hailsham-based allotment holders

'Hailsham In Pictures' Photography Competition

The judging panel states that the following ideas for photo entries will be considered:

- Floral
- Landscape
- Environmental heritage
- Horticulture
- Biodiversity
- Water conservation and recycling
- Heritage
- Pride of place

A range of factors will be taken into account, including:

- Composition
- Technical ability
- Interpretation of the brief

Who can enter?

- Hailsham residents only (open to both professional and amateur photographers)
